Solid water has a high concentration ions that may affect the taste of water. Heavy water can't hurt you, but can cause up takeoffs of dirt in the pipe and even degrade old types of iron pipes. Installing a water softener can be done by anyone, but it will take some time and quite a bit of work. Turn off the water, enter your house, finding the water to turn off the valve. It will be a large valve located somewhere on the water pipe. Turn the valve handle completely closed, which will be indicated without being able to rotate the handle anymore. Find a faucet and turn on the water, the water will not come out if you properly turn off the water. Place the water softener on the pipe that connects the water entrance to the water heater. Turn off the water flow valve so that the water does not flow back. Visit the goggles and work gloves at this point as you will use the reciprocal saws further. Place the bucket under the pipe that connects the input valve to the water heater to collect water droplets. Turn on the responding saw and place the blade on the PVC pipe between the water heater and the input valve. Seen through the pipe, being careful not to cut any other pipes or wires nearby. Repeat this incision on the water valve water heater tube so that the pipe can come for free. Pull out the pipe and place it in a bucket. File down the raw edges of the PVC pipe left in the valves on both sides. You don't need it to be a smooth mirror, you just want to remove any debris that may come loose when you turn the water back on. Wrap the sides of the pipes sticking out of any valve into the plug tape. Three layers will do. Squeeze the input pipe mouth water softener over the pipe and then fasten it with an off-clip. Tighten the clip with a flat-head screwdriver, rotating clockwise to tighten. Don't use the power driver as PVC can be hacked. Squeeze the socket pipe mouth water softener on a PVC pipe sticking out of the water heater water valve and provide with an off-clip as well. Plug at the edges of the joints on each PVC pipe. You can't use too much seals so it's easy to cover it. Connect the water softener to the ground socket and then turn it on through the switch on the side. First, open the water valve at the entrance, and then open the valve on the water heater. Now you will have soft water.
